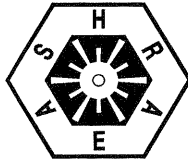

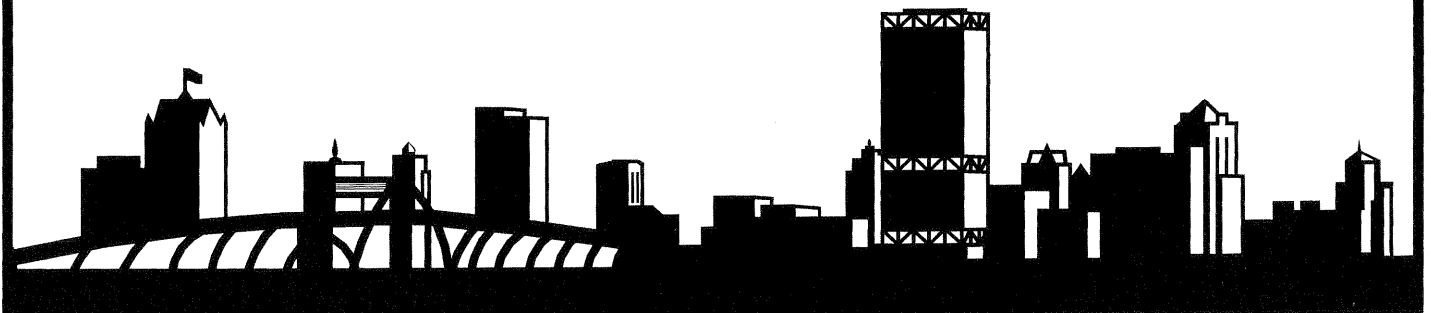

As Maggie said, the summer flew by, to this edition of the Badgeraire is much abbreviated.

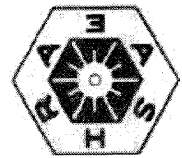
The important information to take from this edition is to get yourself to the first meeting at Discovery World on September 18<sup>th</sup>. We have arranged
