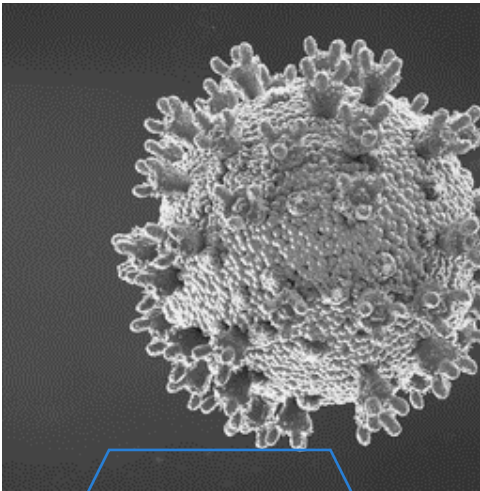

GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS COMMITTEE UPDATE

Wisconsin Economic Development Association References ASHRAE for Building Reopening Guidance

Since the outbreak of COVID-19, the Government Affairs Committee Chairs of all Wisconsin Chapters have conducted virtual meetings with Wisconsin government officials to continue discussing ASHRAE position statements including the [ASHRAE Position Document on Infectious Aerosols](#).

A virtual meeting was held with the offices of Senator Tammy Baldwin (D-WI) on May 7. Various topics were discussed including ASHRAE 90.1 (Energy Standard for Buildings), the ASHRAE Epidemic Task Force, and the AIM Act: a bill supported by ASHRAE that would authorize a 15-year phasedown of hydrofluorocarbon refrigerants (HFCs).

The constant communication with Wisconsin government officials has paid off. The Wisconsin Economic Development Association mentions ASHRAE by name in its COVID-19 guidance for reopening businesses: ASHRAE is specifically mentioned in [Manufacturing Guidelines](#), [Gyms and Fitness Facilities Guidelines](#), [Retail Services Guidelines](#) and [Warehouse and Wholesale Trades Guidelines](#). The guidelines also includes links to the position document on infectious aerosols.

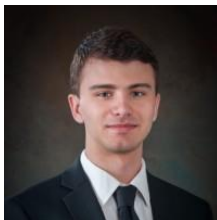
