Which grade is right for me?

Affiliate Membership

is a low cost, introductory membership for new members who are under 30 years of age and are interested in the HVAC&R Industry. This membership grade is perfect for recent graduates who are just getting started in their careers and want to **get plugged into the industry** quickly. Affiliates receive monthly issues of the **ASHRAE Journal** and **Insights** (society newsletter), newsletters and significant discounts on the ASHRAE Handbook and publications, continuing education courses and professional development. Affiliate membership lasts for up to three years and annual dues for this grade of membership are \$40 US.

Associate Membership

is open to anyone who has an interest in matters of design, operation, or maintenance in HVAC&R-related fields. As an Associate Member you will have opportunities to hone technical and professional skills, participate in leadership roles, and influence the global HVAC&R industry marketplace.
